

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Aranmore Swimming Carnival, Monday 19 February

Our annual inter-house swimming carnival for Monday 19th of February will be held at HBF Indoor Stadium. Please read the information below and contact your child's Dean should you have any questions.

1. **Venue: HBF Stadium**, 100 Stephenson Avenue, Mount Claremont. (See map attached).
2. **All years** will have the option to catch a bus from school to & from the Carnival. The bus will leave at **8:15am**. Could you please let Mrs Grace in the PE office know if you would like to use this service by Thursday the 15th of February.
3. **ALL other students need to make their own way to and from the venue.** Students should have arrived at the venue by **8.45am for a 9.00am start**. The Carnival will conclude by **3.00pm** whereupon students will be dismissed from the venue. Students coming from the **city** can catch **Bus 28**, which leaves the Perth Bus port at **8.00am & 8.30am** and will arrive at *HBF Stadium*, (formerly *Challenge Stadium*). A **Bus 28** will depart *HBF Stadium* at **3.28pm** and will return to the city by 4.00pm. You may wish to visit the Transperth *Journey Planner* to get a more information.
4. **Uniform:** Aranmore PE uniform with House shirt. Suitable swimwear/appropriate for fun and competition (one piece preferable). Students who are not appropriately dressed to swim will not be allowed to take part in the carnival and will be asked to remain in their sports uniform.
5. **Upon arrival, students** are to enter the stadium via the main entrance and precede to the indoor pool where they will report to their **House Mentor**, for attendance to be recorded. Students will then move to their House area in the stands and prepare for events. Late students must report to their Dean.
6. **Carnival Format:** Whole school carnival (Yr 7-12). The House carnival will be used as final trials for the ACC swimming team.

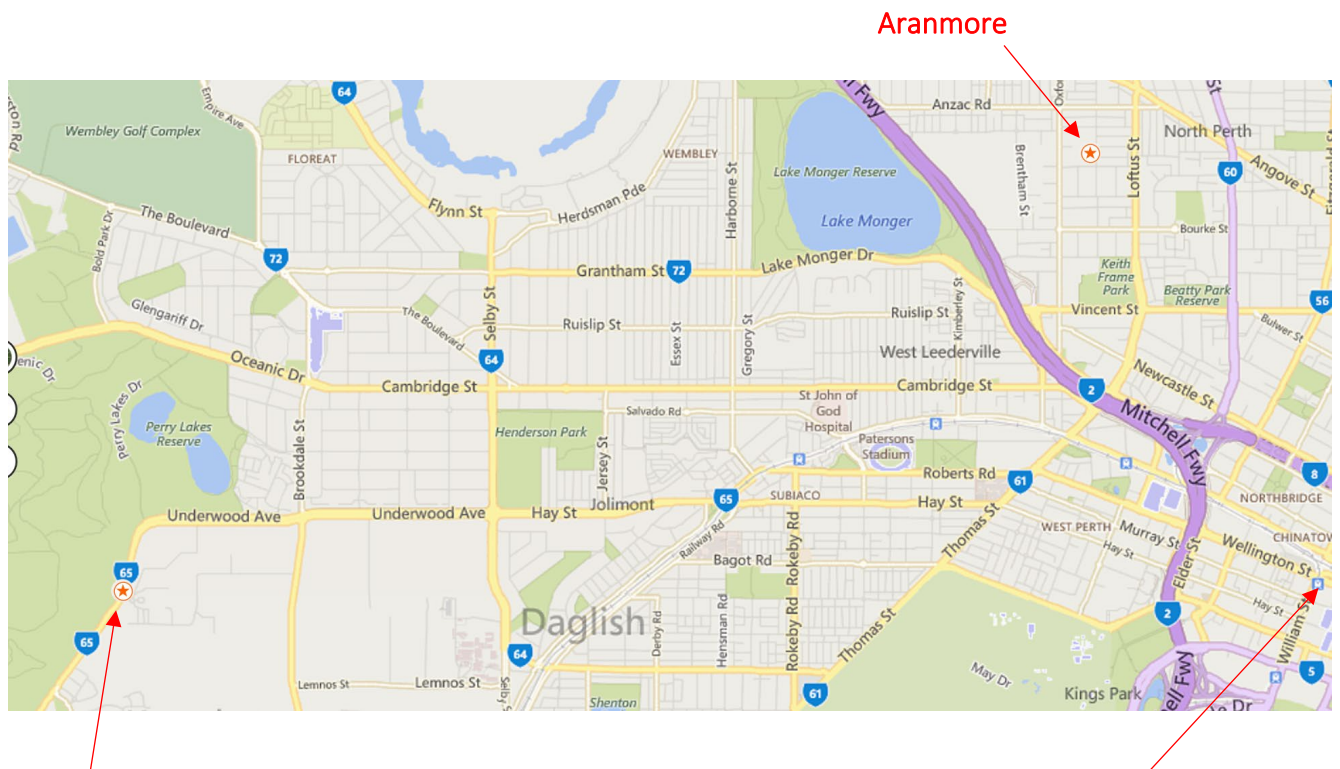
7. **Food and drink.** Students are required to bring their own snacks, food and drinks/drink bottles. Water coolers are available around the venue. **Students will not have access to the venue kiosk this year.**
8. **Prohibited items:** The Stadium does not allow any of the following items at the venue: hairspray, face-paint, and crepe-paper. Students are advised that the swimming carnival is a **mobile phone free** event.
9. **“Bombing” into the pool:** Students are **not permitted** to perform a “bomb” in the pool, any students who do so, will be removed from the swimming carnival.
10. Any **student** who believes that they will **not be able to get to the venue**, please give your name to Mrs Grace by Thursday 15th February. The College will be providing one hired bus departing the College at 8.20am, and returning at approx. 3.20pm, Spaces on this bus **MUST** be booked.
11. Finally, if any **student** needs to leave early their parent/guardian needs to contact the College as per normal College policy. The College will then inform the Deans at the carnival.

On this map, HBF Stadium is indicated with a “Favourites” star, near Underwood Avenue. Aranmore is also indicated on the map with a star.

Students coming from the city could catch Bus 28, which leaves Wellington St (near Forrest place) at 8.00am and will arrive at *HBF Stadium* close to the Athletics stadium at about 8.30am.
