RE: MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION/RE-APPLICATION

All Music Scholarship students are requested to fill out the attached form if they are interested in receiving a Music Scholarship for 2016. Please return this form to the College, by Friday 25 September 2015 (end of Term 3). Any applications received after this date will not be accepted.

Following the submission of this form, you will be contacted regarding an audition date and time early in Term 4 and be informed as to if you are successful late in Term 4. All successful scholarship recipients will be required to read, sign and return the Scholarship Contract.

Scholarships will be awarded as a percentage of school fees, ranging from 10 to 50 per cent. This percentage covers instrumental lessons. For students in Year 7 and part of the Band Program, Aranmore will additionally cover instrumental hire. Students in Years 8-12 are asked to provide their OWN instrument via means of PURCHASE, HIRE or an opportunity to PURCHASE/HIRE through Theo's Music (4 Southport St. West Leederville, W.A. 6007, Phone: (08) 9380 1222, Email: sales@theosmusic.com.au

It is also expected that students maintain their own instrument throughout the year with regards to function and any damages that occur.

The scholarship will be based on a variety of factors:

For EXISTING Music Scholarship holders:

- Practice and dedication to progression on their instrument
- Attendance and punctuality for rehearsals/performances/instrumental lessons
- Attitude towards the program, other students and teachers
- Fulfilment of pre-existing scholarship expectations
- Maintaining a good behavioural standing
- Maintaining at least a C grade average academically

For NEW Music Scholarship holders:

- Prior musical exposure/experience
- Musical potential on a new instrument or existing instrument
- Attitude/enthusiasm towards the music program
- An instrument that is in greater need (clarinet, oboe, bassoon, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, tuba, percussion)

Remember that it is not necessary to be on a scholarship to participate in ANY of the school music activities and we hope that everyone will continue to take part in classes, ensembles and lessons regardless of their scholarship status.

Students who are successfully awarded a scholarship in Years 7 and 8 will be expected to choose Band Class as one of their elective options. Students who are in Years 9-12 will be expected to choose Classroom Music and participate in a number of ensembles.

Students will not be eligible for a Music Scholarship if on another Scholarship at Aranmore Catholic College.
