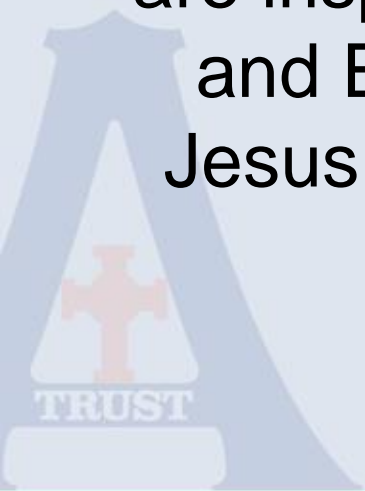





If absent need a note/email/SEQTA message to confirm.

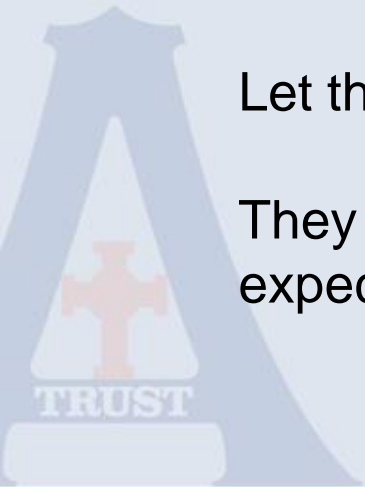
Expectations

Phones

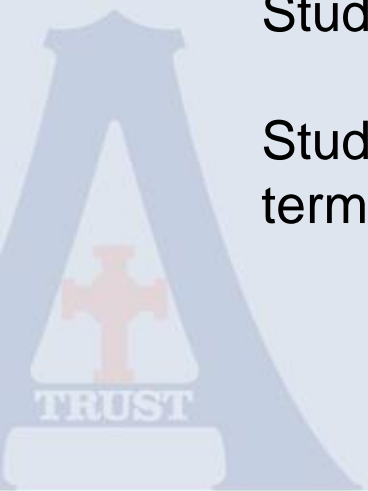
- Mobile phones are not permitted during school hours

Students can borrow laptops from the Library on a short-term basis. Students need to see Dean of students

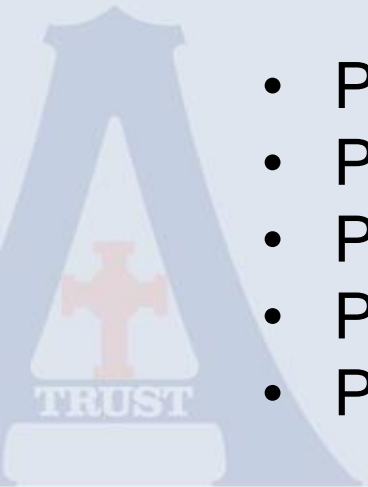

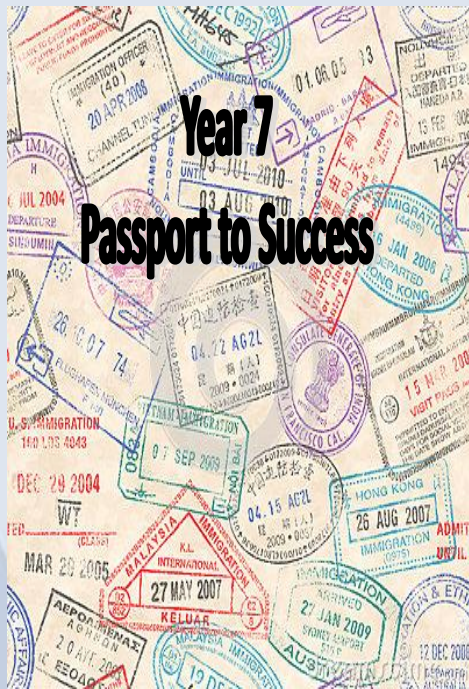

Learning to Learn

One period per week.

Learning to Learn is about getting students to reflect on their learning, and introducing different strategies to improve their concentration, study skills and thinking.

While students do not receive a grade for this course there are two fundamental requirements to participating in this class:

- Be prepared to think.
- Give it your best shot.



Learning to Learn

Some past projects and activities include:

- Introduce philosophy for children programme (P4C). Encourage students to develop critical and creative thinking skills.
- Identify different types of intelligences and multiple learning styles
- Teaching one another rules and strategies of chess
- Programming robots
- Improving typing skills using Typing Tournament
- Lateral thinking exercises by playing and creating escape rooms
- Chess competitions

Learning to Learn

Ultimately, this class is about reflecting on HOW to think, not what to think. And to recognize the difference.



Other Things..

Peer Mentoring – Students have been placed into groups and assigned two Year 10 mentors.

Medication – Please contact student services if students are taking medication on a regular basis.

Testing – started week 2 in Math's and English
