

Aranmore Catholic College Schedule of Fees & Charges 2021

ENROLMENT APPLICATION FEE:

This is a non-refundable payment of \$50.00 (including GST).

ADVANCED FEE ON ACCEPTANCE:

For students commencing, \$200 non-refundable which will be credited to your first fee account

ANNUAL FEE

This is made up as follows:

1. Tuition: 85% of Total Composite Fee

- Equipment and teaching aids, maintenance of equipment, power or chemicals required to make equipment operable
- Handouts, programmes, worksheets, test or examination papers
- Chemicals and other materials used in Science classes
- Religious Education resource books
- Year Level Retreats (previously paid separately)

2. Amenities and Levies: 15% of Composite Fee

- Book Levies, various subject fees
- School publications and Information handbooks
- Careers advice, Social Work
- Student Insurance Cover
- House Group Events
- Sporting Facility Hire
- Access to eLearning websites (Including Clickview)
- Software Licenses

- Additional fees will be charged for excursions, camps and trips except when a whole year group attends

ADDITIONAL FEES FOR OPTIONAL ITEMS

Instrumental Music and Singing Tutors

If you chose these lessons a fee of \$1056 or \$1706 for ATAR Tuition will apply. This fee is paid to the Tutors. (Non ATAR 32 half hour lessons at \$33 each. ATAR lessons 26 hour lessons at \$66 each)

OnSite

The OnSite Program costs the College \$1000 per student but is subsidised by the College. The subsidised cost charged to fees is \$450.

DISCOUNTS

Sibling Discounts

When two children are attending, the second child will be entitled to a discount of 20% off Tuition Fees.

When three children are attending, the third child will be entitled to a 40% discount off Tuition Fees.

When four children are attending, the fourth child will be entitled to a 100% discount off Tuition Fees.

Health Care Card Discount

Families with a current Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card are entitled to have each student's Tuition Fees reduced to \$1500. If you hold one of these cards, please ensure you bring it to the College each time it is renewed.

Holders of these cards may also be entitled to a State Government clothing subsidy. You can apply for this assistance by contacting the College for an appointment with Sister Janina in Term One.

Special Discounts

Where special circumstances exist and a family is not entitled to Health Care Card Discount, discounts will be considered with the completion of the appropriate application form. Please contact the College for an application form if you are experiencing financial difficulties.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

A full terms notice of withdrawal of a child from the College is required. Failure to give the correct notice will incur a term's fees in lieu of notice.

AGREEMENT TO PAY FEES

When you sign the Enrolment Form you commit to paying school fees as set each year. If you are unable to meet your fee obligations, you should contact the College for assistance and a payment plan.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

School Uniforms cannot be discounted, however, suitable second-hand uniforms may be available. If you hold a Health Care Card, you may be entitled to a State Government Uniform Subsidy. Contact Sr Janina to see if you qualify and to make an appointment to apply for the subsidy.

PAYMENT METHODS

There are many payment options and a form accompanying your first fee statement should be returned to indicate your payment choice.
