The College Athletics carnival is being held on Thursday 13 August at the WA Athletics Stadium, Mount Claremont. This is a whole school event and the expectation is that all students attend.

***If your child wishes to compete in the 1500m event, they will be bused from the College at 8.00am, or they can make their own way to the Stadium to run at 8.30am.**

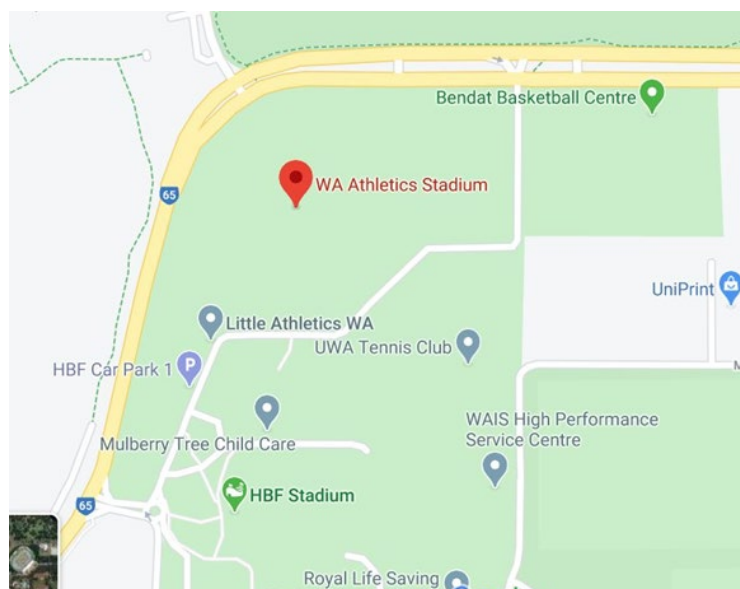
There are several ways students can get to the stadium. In the past, students have made their own way to and from the Stadium for this event. This year students have the additional option of being transported by bus from the College to and from the Stadium. **(IEC and Aboriginal students will meet at the College and will travel by bus to and from the Stadium).**

To indicate that your child/children would like to use this bus service, you are asked to use the link below and register your children. If you do not want to use the bus, then your child is to make their own arrangements to get to and from the Stadium.

The buses will depart the College at 8.50am and then at the end of the carnival, depart the Stadium at 2.35pm arriving back at Aranmore approximately 3.00pm. **If you do not book a place on the bus for your child to get to the Stadium, they cannot use this bus to return to the College.**

Students who choose to make their own way to the WA Athletics Stadium should arrive by **8.30am**. The Carnival should conclude by **2.35pm**, whereupon students will be dismissed from the venue. Students coming from the **city** can catch **Bus 28**, which leaves the **Perth Bus Port at 7.23am & 8:01am**, and will arrive at *HBF Stadium, (formerly Challenge Stadium)* close to the Athletics stadium at about 7.50am & 8:30 respectively.

Uniform: Aranmore PE uniform with House shirt. Students must bring appropriate sun protection (sunscreen, Aranmore-hat, sunglasses, etc.). Extra sunscreen will be available from the PE staff.

Upon arrival, students make their way to their house area in the main stand to receive competitor numbers for the carnival. There will be a short break mid-morning to complete the attendance check.

Food and drink. The **Stadium kiosk** will be available for purchasing food; however, the **prices are much higher** than our school-canteen. Hence, students are encouraged to bring their own snacks, lunch and drinks/drink bottles. There are water fountains at the venue.

Prohibited items: The Stadium does not allow any of the following items at the venue: hairspray, face-paint, zinc, and crepe-paper. Students are reminded that Personal Electronic Devices, including mobile phones, may not be used during the day, as per a normal school rule.
